

ALUMNI SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION PROCEDURES AND TERMS OF REFERENCE

The Nelson Waldorf School is offering a Scholarship to an Alumnus of the Nelson Waldorf School.

A committee will be appointed by the Nelson Waldorf School Faculty who will review applications and award the scholarship.

The following criteria are required in consideration of Scholarship applicants.

1. Applications must be received by the Nelson Waldorf School not later than June 11th.
2. One Scholarship or award of \$500 will be given to the successful applicant.
3. Applicants must meet the following criteria:
 - The applicant must be currently enrolled or have applied to a post-secondary institution.
 - The applicant must not have received a previous Nelson Waldorf School Scholarship award.
 - The applicant must have attended Nelson Waldorf School for a minimum of three years.
 - The applicant must submit a response to questions (see attached) and submit a 300-400 word essay (see attached criteria), or if requested meet with the Scholarship Committee.
 - The applicant must give permission for the essay to be referenced as an "Alumnus Perspective" on the School Website.
 - The applicant must be willing to speak to parents as an Alumnus of the School, if requested.

All Applicants will be notified of the results of this competition by July 30th.

Question Sheet or Essay Content to include the following:

1. Name, address, and years of attendance at the Nelson Waldorf School.
2. List your current and past endeavours in the following realms:
 - a. Creativity
 - b. Physical Activity
 - c. Service to the Community
 - d. Other
3. What are your goals and aspirations?
4. Is there anything else you would like us to know about you?

Essay:

Please write a 300-400 word essay in which you describe how your Waldorf education has influenced who you are as a person, how it affects your present life, and how it influences your future aspirations.
